READ IT	God's Word * Matthew 28:18-20 Revelation 7:9
PARAPHRASE IT	My Words
TALK ABOUT IT	What did you like from the passages? What did you learn about God? What did you learn about people? What did you learn about following Jesus?
POINT IT OUT	 Definition: Mission defines what we do. Vision is a picture of what will happen if we fulfill our mission. It is every Christian's mission to MAKE DISCIPLES as commanded by Jesus. (Matt. 28:18-20) As we do the Great Commission (Matt. 28:18-20), it accomplishes the vision of seeing a great multitude worshipping Jesus. (Rev. 7:9)

POINT IT OUT	 Definition: A <u>strategy</u> is <u>plan of action</u> that enables us to accomplish our mission and vision. CCF aims to bring each member from where they are to where God wants them to be through the CCF Discipleship Process: <u>ENGAGE</u>, <u>EVANGELIZE</u>, <u>EQUIP</u>, <u>EMPOWER</u>.

- Our main strategy and structure to fulfill this process is in a small group discipleship as Jesus and the early church modeled it. (Mark 3:14; Acts 2:46-47)

These values deem most important to the organization which guide its decision-making process. CCF Core Value: L ove God, Love Others (Matt. 22:36-40; John 13:34-35; Luke 6:27–28; Matthew 7:12)

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POINT IT OUT

- Love is the greatest commandment. It is the sum of the law. (Matt. 22:36-40)
- Love is our most effective witness to the world and is best practiced in small groups. (John 13:34-35).



POINT IT OUT

CCF Core Value:

O bey God's Word and Authorities

- God's word is the primary source for knowing God and His ways. Since the Bible is inspired by God (2 Timothy 3:16), it is our supreme authority in all matters of faith, doctrine, and conduct.
- As followers of Jesus, we show our love for God by keeping and obeying His commands. (John 14:23-24)
- God sovereignly ordains people in authority in our lives for us to submit and obey except when it is clearly against the Word of God. (Romans 13:1-2; Acts 5:29) He is sovereign over human authorities. (Proverbs 21:1)
 - 1. Parental authority (Eph. 6:1-3)
 - 2. Husband's authority (Eph. 5:22)
 - 3. Employer (1 Pet. 2:18)
 - 4. Church Leadership (Heb. 13:17)
 - 5. Government (1 Pet. 2:13,15)
- There are blessings in obeying: it is for our protection, guidance, growing our character and faith, and for knowing God's will.

BIBLE VERSES

SESSION 1

Matthew 28:18-20

And Jesus came up and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. ¹⁹ Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ teaching them to observe all that I commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

Revelation 7:9

After these things I looked, and behold, a great multitude which no one could count, from every nation and all tribes and peoples and tongues, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed in white robes, and palm branches were in their hands;

SESSION 2

Mark 3:14

And He appointed twelve, so that they would be with Him and that He could send them out to preach,

Acts 2:46-47

Day by day continuing with one mind in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, they were taking their meals together with gladness and sincerity of heart, ⁴⁷ praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord was adding to their number day by day those who were being saved.

2 Timothy 2:2

The things which you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses, entrust these to faithful men who will be able to teach others also.

SESSION 3

Matthew 22:36-40

"Teacher, which is the great commandment in the Law?" ³⁷ And He said to him, "'You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind.' ³⁸ This is the great and foremost commandment. ³⁹ The second is like it, 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' ⁴⁰ On these two commandments depend the whole Law and the Prophets."

John 14:23-24

Jesus answered and said to him, "If anyone loves Me, he will keep My word; and My Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our abode with him. ²⁴ He who does not love Me does not keep My words; and the word which you hear is not Mine, but the Father's who sent Me.

Romans 13:1-2

Every person is to be in subjection to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and those which exist are established by God. ² Therefore whoever resists authority has opposed the ordinance of God; and they who have opposed will receive condemnation upon themselves.

SESSION 4

Ephesians 2:10

For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand so that we would walk in them.

1 Peter 4:10

As each one has received a special gift, employ it in serving one another as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.

Deuteronomy 6:4-7

"Hear, O Israel! The Lord is our God, the Lord is one! ⁵ You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might. ⁶ These words, which I am commanding you today, shall be on your heart. ⁷ You shall teach them diligently to your sons and shall talk of them when you sit in your house and when you walk by the way and when you lie down and when you rise up.

1 Timothy 3:4-5

He must be one who manages his own household well, keeping his children under control with all dignity ⁵ (but if a man does not know how to manage his own household, how will he take care of the church of God?),

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
