2. **Conduct one-on-one conversations** with your potential leaders to understand their readiness to lead. **Use the GLC 3D's guide to DISCOVER, DEVELOP and DEPLOY New Dgroup Leaders.**

II. DEVELOP

This phase is to equip your 1-2 potential leaders to start their own discipleship group.

1. Make sure to apply the principles and lessons from Books 9-12.
2. Develop Practical Leadership Skills by:
 - a. Training them to lead discussions and engage group members.
 - b. Teach them to confidently share Scripture, facilitate discussions, and help others apply biblical truth in their lives. (Use available GLC materials – <https://glc.ccf.org.ph> , 4Ws and other resources from the CCF Website.
 - c. Modeling and teaching them about prayer - both personal and corporate. Attend Pray O'Clock and Prayer and Fasting sessions with them.
3. Mentor them by giving feedback and addressing their concerns. Make sure to apply the lessons learned from the Mentoring and Coaching sessions.
4. Let them shadow you during Dgroup meetings. Help them practice leading – whether in prayer time, facilitating discussions, or teaching a portion of a Bible study. You may also encourage them to facilitate at retreats. Offer them feedback to help them grow.
5. Use the **360° Feedback Mechanism to track and guide their leadership development aligned with CCF Core Values.**

III. DEPLOY

This phase is about releasing these potential leaders to start their own Dgroup and begin making disciples.

1. Encourage your potential leaders to start their own Dgroup. Emphasize the importance of being disciple-makers. (EMAD)
2. Set clear expectations by:
 - Reminding them that their role is to disciple others, teach the Bible and help their group grow spiritually.
 - Helping them set goals, encouraging them to launch their own Dgroup **within 4-8 months.**
3. Provide support by regularly checking in and offering guidance as they lead their Dgroup. Be available to help with any issues and encourage them continually.
4. Have your potential leader(s) start a new Dgroup within the set timeframe.
