# HOW TO USE THIS WORKBOOK

The workbook includes the Bible lesson, and individual and Dgroup learning activities to help you get the most out of your meetings. There are four parts in every session: Welcome, Talk About It, Apply It and Pray It.

# Welcome —

# Talk About It —

This is where you go through the Bible lesson with the group. This is also where the members of the group get a chance to express more of their insights, questions and thoughts about the Bible lesson. They can do it in writing, doodling or drawing, and sharing with the rest of the group.

# Apply It —

This section is accomplished outside the group meeting time. There are suggested individual or group Life Apps that will hopefully help you experience life transformation as you apply God's truth in practical ways.

# Pray It —


Suggested prayer points based on the lesson asking for the Lord's grace in applying what has been learned after the study.

# **CCF MISSION**

Our mission is "to Honor God and make Christ-Committed Followers who will make Christ-Committed Followers".

# A. Every Christian's Mission is to Make Disciples

The Great Commission (Matthew 28:18-20)

<sup>18</sup> And Jesus came up and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. <sup>19</sup> Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup> teaching them to observe all that I commanded you; and Io, I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

The main verb is "make disciples".

# How do you make disciples?

You make disciples as you" go", as you "baptize", as you "teach". (to observe/practice/obey all of God's commands).

A disciple is a believer but is more than a believer; he is a follower of Jesus.

**MISSION** defines what we do, and **VISION** is a picture of what will happen if we fulfill our mission.

# What are some differences between MISSION and VISION?

Mission comes first; once you know your mission God will give you the vision.

#### **II. CCF VISION**

# **CCF VISION**

Our vision is to see a movement of millions of Christ-committed followers meeting in small groups, transforming lives, families, communities and nations, by the power of God and for the glory of God.

Do you embrace this vision that God has given us? You and I each have a small part to play in God's grand vision!

God has given you a job description, so let's find out what God wants to do with your life!

To get to where God wants us to be, to do what God wants us to do, we need to be intentional. We need a strategy.

#### **III. WHAT IS A STRATEGY?**

A strategy is a simple plan of action that enables us to accomplish our mission and vision. It aims to bring every CCF member from where they are to where God wants them to be.

While mission does not change, strategy can change.

Vision and core values rarely change but a strategy depends on the people and situation working to accomplish the mission, vision and core values.



## A. THE CCF DISCIPLESHIP JOURNEY

What is the process that we bring people through in the Discipleship Journey?


#### THE PROCESS:

**ENGAGE** — We build relationships with those who don't know Jesus and share the gospel with them.

**EDIFY** – Together, we grow in knowing Jesus and becoming more like Him in a Dgroup

**EQUIP** — We train Dgroup members to lead their own Dgroup.

**EMPOWER** – Dgroup leaders help their Dgroup members start their own Dgroups as they make disciples who will make disciples.



## **READ 1 CORINTHIANS 3:1-4**

Our goal is to help infants in the faith, or "immature" believers grow to maturity and become spiritual parents themselves. Mature believers who are "fishers of men", making disciples who make disciples.

What is our strategy to make disciples who will make disciples?

#### **B. STRATEGY**

Our simple strategy of making disciples to make disciples is based on the following principles:

1. Every Member a Discipler (EMAD)

Read Ephesians 4:11-13

What are the roles of pastors and Bible teachers, and who are responsible for carrying out the ministry?

# 2. On-the-job training

# Read Luke 10:1

What practical training did Jesus use to equip people for ministry, and how did He put this into action?

3. Discipleship Group (Dgroup)

Read Mark 3:14, Acts 2:46-47

According to Acts 2:46–47, how did the early church follow Jesus' model of discipleship in their daily lives?

Mark 3:14 states, "And He appointed twelve, so that they would be with Him and that He could send them out to preach."

What was the purpose of Jesus's appointment of the twelve? What discipleship strategy does this illustrate?

Discipleship group is our basic structure and the main ministry in CCF. It is the model used by Jesus and the early Church.

If you follow God's model, there will be joy, praises to God and favor with all the people. The Lord was adding to their number those who were being saved day by day! **Evangelism is not done once a week** — **It's daily and it's a way of life.** 

# 4. Spiritual Multiplication

# Read 2 Timothy 2:2

List the generations implied in 2 Timothy 2:2. How many generations are mentioned?

Paul's model and our strategy to fulfill the mission is known as "spiritual multiplication" --- make disciples (Paul) who will make disciples (Timothy) who will make disciples (faithful men), who will make disciples (others).

# **Benefits of Discipleship Group**

**Relationship:** It's difficult to build relationships with 100 people; it's much easier to build relationships with a small group of disciples.

**Not dependent on one:** Dgroup members learn to be interdependent with each other. Others can step into the role of leader/facilitator if necessary.

**Accountability:** Blind spots can be addressed in a Dgroup.

**Modeling:** You must be up close to see how ministry is done.

**Team ministry:** There is no "Lone Ranger" in the ministry! You have to be in a team as you minister to others.

**Character-building:** As iron sharpens iron, God builds your character through your relationships in the Dgroup.

**Mutual care & encouragement:** Members give mutual care and encouragement. You build each other up in the Dgroup.

# **CORE VALUES**

# **Learning Nugget**

As members of CCF, how we live our lives should also reflect the core values that are "encoded" in our church DNA.

# **TALK ABOUT IT**

#### **Definition of Core Values**

Core values define who we are and how we do things in order to accomplish our mission-vision. These are the values that are most important to the organization and guide its decision-making process.

Your core values will shape how you strategize to accomplish your mission and vision. Another word for core values is the "culture" of the organization.



### **B.** Obey God's Word and Authorities

# 1. Obey God's Word

#### Read 1 John 5:2-3

By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God and observe His commandments. For **this is the love of God**, that **we keep His commandments**; and His commandments are not burdensome.

a. What evidences show that we love God?

### Read John 14:23-24

Jesus answered and said to him, "If anyone loves Me, he will keep My word; and My Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our abode with him. He who does not love Me does not keep My words;

This is a special promise of the manifest Presence of God the Father and God the Son in your life! You will never experience intimacy with God if there is no obedience. If you love God, you will obey Him and because you love Him and obey Him, Jesus says you will experience His presence.

The antidote for sin is very simple: love God more than you love yourself. Then you will give up the sin because of your love for the Lord.

# **Read 2 Timothy 3:16-17**

All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness; so that the man of God may be adequate, equipped for every good work.

When you obey God, it includes obedience to authorities because the Bible is very clear on this:

#### Read Romans 13:1-2

Every person is to be in subjection to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and those which exist are established by God. <sup>2</sup> Therefore whoever resists authority has opposed the ordinance of God; and they who have opposed will receive condemnation upon themselves.

# **CCF MEMBERSHIP**



This session will help you understand the biblical basis for church membership and the blessings of being part of a local church—specifically, CCF.

It will also explain the responsibilities that come with being a member and encourage each of us to join a Discipleship Group (Dgroup) to experience the joy and benefits of doing life together in Christ. We hope you will take the next step and become part of one.

# I. BIBLICAL BASIS FOR CHURCH MEMBERSHIP

A. Believers are members of the **UNIVERSAL** Church. (1 Cor 12:13)

- The spiritual baptism that unites believers into the body of Christ. This unity is through the Holy Spirit who baptizes and empowers believers. (1 Cor. 12:13)
- This is also symbolized by water baptism. In CCF, we regularly
  offer a Baptism Class followed by a water baptism ceremony.
  You are strongly encouraged to join the next Baptism Class if
  you haven't been baptized yet.

B. Believers should be members of a **LOCAL** Church. (Acts 2:46, 1 Corinthians 16:19, Colossians 4:15)

C. Local Church Membership is a biblical **COMMAND.** (Hebrews 10:25)

# In CCF, this is how we define local church membership:

- CCF members are believers who have formally accepted and are committed to abide by and adhere by CCF's Mission, Vision, Core Values, Statement of Faith, and Governance.
- They affirm, support, and seek to live out these tenets by the grace of God. They have committed to make themselves accountable to the leadership of CCF by being part of a Discipleship Group (Article III CCF Church Governance).

D. Shows your **COMMITMENT** to Christ and His Church. (Romans 12:5)

In CCF, your decision to accept Jesus as Savior and Lord, and your commitment to follow Him for the rest of your life is symbolized by water baptism.

Your commitment to CCF as your local church is symbolized by the CCF Commitment Card. It is provided to all registered CCF Dgroup members. You may apply through the website link provided in VII. Your Next Steps CCF towards DMembership.

A Dgroup, short for Discipleship Group, is a small group of people that meets regularly, shares their lives with each other, studies the Bible together, and members are accountable to each other, all in the pursuit of becoming more Christ-like.

Care – It is a spiritual family where people support, encourage, and pray for each other.

Character – It helps build character through mutual accountability and building each other up.

Collaboration – It is a place where serving God can be done shoulder to shoulder.

- 1. The job of pastors and Bible teachers is to equip, to train those who are supposed to do the ministry. The saints (Christians).
- 2. The model of Jesus for equipping people for ministry was on the on-the-job-training; the Lord appointed 70 others and sent them out in pairs ahead of him.
- 3. Jesus' discipleship strategy was to appoint twelve disciples so that they would be with Him, so He can spend time with them for discipleship and then send them out to do the ministry.

Acts 2:46-47, Jesus' followers, the early church copied Jesus' model --- day by day continuing to meet in the temple (big group) and breaking bread (having fellowship) from house to house (small group).

II. CCF Core Values

#### A. Love God, Love Others

- 2. Our most powerful tool, our most powerful instrument for witnessing, is love.
- 3. The same way you want them to treat you.

5. It is a vital part of our spiritual life. Being part of a Dgroup is really not optional; there's no way you can obey the Lord to love one another apart from being part of a Dgroup.

#### B. Obey God's Word and Authorities

1. Obey God's Word

1 John 5:2-3 The evidence of loving God is firstly, loving the children of God, and observing (obeying) the commandments of God.

The love of God this is not sentimental; it's not something romantic. We love God by keeping His commandments. His commandments are not burdensome because if you love God, obeying Him is a delight.

John 14:23-24 Jesus said, "if anyone love Me he will keep My word...", so if you are disobeying God, then Jesus is saying, "you don't love Me".

Why is it important to know God's Word if we truly love Him? If we love God, we will want to know God's Word. You cannot obey God's word if you don't know the Bible. If you love God you will want to know what He wants, what He deserves.

## 2. Obey God's ordained authorities Romans 13:1-2 As believers, we are called to submit to governing authorities, recognizing that resisting authority is equivalent to

opposing God's established order.

- Ephesians 6:1-3 Parental Authority and God's promise of blessing.
- Ephesians 5:22 Husband's Authority and the wife's submission is ultimately an act of submission and trust in God, not just in her husband.
- 1 Peter 2:18 Employer. Respect for authority is shown through submission and obedience, even to those who are harsh Hebrews 13:17 Church Leadership. When members obey their leaders, it brings joy to the leaders rather than grief, creating a healthy and thriving church environment.
- 1 Peter 2:13,15 Government. Obeying human institutions (governments, leaders) is ultimately an act of obedience to God, as He establishes authority. It aligns with God's will.
- 3. If God wants to accomplish something, nobody can stop Him. God will use human authorities to direct your path.

4. You only disobey when authorities are asking you to do something against the Bible, something immoral or outrightly evil.

#### C. Volunteer

- 1. Galatians 5:13. The Bible is saying that you cannot use the grace of God as an opportunity to commit sin. On the contrary if you love God, you will love and serve others.
- 2. Ephesians 2:10 We are saved to serve.
- 3. 1 Peter 4:10 We are gifted to serve.
- 4. 1 Peter 2:9 Every member is a minister-discipler.

#### D. Engage the Family

1. Deut. 6:4-7

Love God first (v4-5) – Parents must have a deep love for God before teaching their children.

- Live out God's word (v6) Parents must first internalize and practice God's commands.
- Teach Daily (v7) Faith should be taught in everyday moments, not just in formal settings.
- Home is the first church Parents, not pastors, are the primary spiritual mentors.
- Lead by example. children learn best by watching their parents live out their faith.
- 2. 1 Timothy 3:4-5, 12. A godly husband cultivates his family's faith and obedience, demonstrating love, loyalty, and integrity towards his wife, and effectively managing his children and household.

#### **APPENDIX A**

#### **CCF STATEMENT OF FAITH**

#### **ABOUT THE BIBLE**

We believe that the Bible, composed of 39 Old Testament books and 27 New Testament books, is the Word of God, supernaturally inspired, inerrant in its original form, infallible, so that it is our supreme authority in all matters of faith, doctrine and conduct.

#### **ABOUT GOD**

We believe that there is only one GOD eternally existent in three persons – Father, Son and Holy Spirit. He is the Creator of Heaven and Earth.

#### **ABOUT JESUS CHRIST**

We believe that Jesus Christ in the flesh was both God and Man, that He was conceived by the Holy Spirit and born of a virgin. He lived a sinless life. He was crucified and He died to pay the penalty of death for our sins. By His shed blood, the Lord Jesus Christ made a perfect sacrifice for sin once and for all time and was raised from the dead on the third day. Later He ascended to the Father's right hand where He is the Head of the Church and intercedes for believers. We believe He is coming again to the Earth bodily and visibly to set up His Kingdom.

#### **ABOUT THE HOLY SPIRIT**

We believe that the Holy Spirit is God and possesses all the Divine attributes. He indwells all believers, baptizes and seals all believers at the moment they trust in Jesus Christ to be their only Savior and Lord. He controls and empowers all true believers to live the Christian life in response to their obedience, confession of sin, and yieldness to Him.

#### **ABOUT SALVATION**

We believe that Salvation, with its forgiveness of sins, impartation of a new nature, and eternal life, is a free gift from God received when a person trusts in Jesus Christ to be their only Savior and Lord. Salvation is given by God's grace and cannot be earned by man through good works, baptism, church membership or any other means. (Ephesians 2:8–9)

#### **ABOUT GOOD WORKS**

We believe that good works are not the means of salvation but are the expected product in the life of a true believer in Christ. It is every believer's responsibility to pursue a life of good works through the power of the indwelling Holy Spirit.

#### **ABOUT EVERY CHRISTIAN'S MISSION**

We believe that it is God's will and command for every Christian to be actively engaged in telling others how to establish a personal relationship with God through faith in Jesus Christ and in discipling those who respond to this good news of salvation pursuant to Matthew 28:18–20.

#### **ABOUT BAPTISM**

We believe that water baptism by immersion is an act of obedience to Christ's command. It is a public confession of our personal faith in Jesus Christ. (Matthew 28:19)

#### **ABOUT THE CHURCH**

The universal church is composed of all true believers who have trusted in Christ as their Lord and Savior and are committed to follow Him. The local church is composed of believers in a specific locality who have chosen to abide by that local church's Mission, Vision, Core Values and Statements of Faith.

#### **ABOUT MARRIAGE**

We believe that marriage is the uniting of one man and one woman in a single, exclusive union, as delineated in Scripture. (Genesis 2:18–25.) We believe that God intends sexual intimacy to occur only between a man and a woman who are married to each other. (1 Corinthians 6:18; 7:2-5; Hebrews 13:4)

Because God has ordained marriage and defined it as the covenant relationship between a man, a woman, and Himself, CCF will only recognize and solemnize marriages between a biological man and a biological woman who are committed to follow Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior.

#### **ABOUT GENDER**

We believe that God wonderfully and immutably creates each person as biologically male or biologically female. These two distinct, complementary genders together reflect the image and nature of God. (Genesis 1:26-27.) Rejection of one's biological sex is a rejection of the image of God within that person.

#### **ABOUT THE SANCTITY OF HUMAN LIFE**

We believe that all human life is sacred and created by God in His image. Human life is of inestimable worth in all its dimensions, including pre-born babies, the aged, the physically or mentally challenged, and every other stage or condition from conception through natural death. This statement of faith does not exhaust the extent of our beliefs.

We believe that the Bible itself, as the inspired and infallible Word of God that speaks with final authority concerning truth, morality, and the proper conduct of mankind, is the sole and final source of all that we believe. CCF's Board of Elders is the final interpretive authority on the Bible's meaning and application and shall have final authority in all matters of church governance, as set forth and described in these By-Laws.




