| POINT IT OUT  | The Father is God, the Son is God, the Holy Spirit is God. We have only one God, eternally existing in 3 distinct Persons – the Father is not the Son, the Son is not the Holy Spirit, the Holy Spirit is not the Father. They are distinct Persons but one Being. (Mark 1:10-11, Matthew 28:19) |

- The Holy Spirit is God and possesses all divine attributes. He is all-knowing (1 Corinthians 2:11), all-powerful (Luke 1:35, Mark 10:27), ever-present (Psalm 139:7).
- The Holy Spirit indwells all believers and baptizes them the moment they trust Jesus Christ to be their only Savior and Lord. He controls all true believers and empowers them to live the Christian life in response to their obedience, confession of sins and submission to Him. (John 16:7-13)
