FIVE IMPORTANT TRUTHS

1. **God loves you and he desires that you have eternal and abundant life.**

Eternal Life

BIBLE VERSE: _____

For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish, but **have eternal life**.

Abundant Life

BIBLE VERSE: _____

The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I came that they may have **life, and have it abundantly**.

2. Man has a sin problem that separates him from god.

BIBLE VERSE: _____

for **all** have **sinned** and **fall short** of the **glory of God**,

BIBLE VERSE: _____

For the **wages of sin is death**, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

BIBLE VERSE: _____

And in as much as it is appointed for men to **die** once and **after** this comes **judgment**

BIBLE VERSE: _____

But for the cowardly and unbelieving and abominable and murderers and immoral persons and sorcerers and idolaters and **all liars**, their part will be in the lake that burns with fire and brimstone, which is the **second death**.

Objection: “But I am basically a good person.”

BIBLE VERSE: _____

For whoever keeps the whole law and yet stumbles in one point, he has become guilty of all.

Objection: “But I have tried to lead a good life.”

BIBLE VERSE: _____

He saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness, but according to His mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit,

BIBLE VERSE: _____

²¹ You have heard that the ancients were told, ‘You shall not commit murder’ and ‘Whoever commits murder shall be liable to the court.’ ²² But I say to you that everyone who is angry with his brother shall be guilty before the court;

Objection: “But I have not done anything scandalous like adultery or murder!”

BIBLE VERSE: _____

²⁷ You have heard that it was said, ‘You shall not commit adultery’; ²⁸ but I say to you that everyone who looks at a woman with lust for her has already committed adultery with her in his heart.

3. Jesus Christ is god’s way to heaven.

BIBLE VERSE: _____

Jesus said to him, “I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me.”

BIBLE VERSE: _____

But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

BIBLE VERSE: _____

and He Himself bore our sins in His body on the cross, so that we might die to sin and live to righteousness; for by His wounds you were healed.

BIBLE VERSE: _____

²⁴ being justified as a gift by His grace through the redemption which is in Christ Jesus; ²⁵ whom God displayed publicly as a propitiation in His blood through faith. This was to demonstrate His righteousness, because in the forbearance of God He passed over the sins previously committed;”

4. The resurrection of Jesus Christ assures us that he can fulfill his promise of eternal life.

³ For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received, that **Christ died for our sins** according to the Scriptures, ⁴ and that He was **buried**, and that He was **raised on the third day** according to the Scriptures,

³ concerning His Son, who was born of a descendant of David according to the flesh, ⁴ who was declared the Son of God with power by the resurrection from the dead, according to the Spirit of holiness, Jesus Christ our Lord,

BIBLE VERSE: _____

²⁵ Jesus said to her, “**I am the resurrection and the life**; he who believes in Me will live even if he dies, ²⁶ and everyone who lives and believes in Me will never die. Do you believe this?

BIBLE VERSE: _____

For the wages of sin is death, but the **free gift of God is eternal life** in Christ Jesus our Lord.

¹¹ And the testimony is this, that God has given us eternal life, and this life is in His Son. ¹² He who has the Son has the life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have the life.

⁸ For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God; ⁹ not as a result of works, so that no one may boast.
